

The health of street youth: a general review and results of a study of female prostitution

The Montréal street youth research program began in 1995 with a survey of HIV seroprevalence and associated risk factors among 909 youth aged 13-25 years. Since then, several health and behavioral issues were examined using various research strategies, including cross-sectional and longitudinal studies. One of the co-investigators, Dr. Jean-François Boivin, will present a recent review of the international literature on the health of street youth as well as results of a study of female prostitution in this population.
