In BC, nationally and internationally, women's service providers, in collaboration with researchers and women, have developed 'trauma informed' programming for women experiencing multiple issues. In this session, women's services in BC will describe key aspects of the trauma-related programming they have piloted, and the challenges that remain in sustaining innovative, integrated support for women who need it.

An overview of the findings from the Women, Co-occurring Disorders and Violence Study sponsored by the US Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration on the system wide approach taken in 13 American sites will also be provided.
