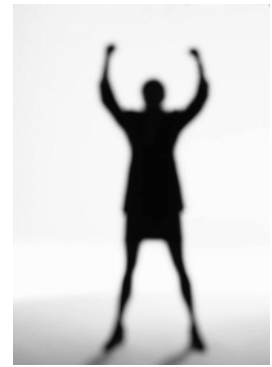


Women, Girls and Self-Harm

Self-harm among women and girls in Canada is a serious health issue. In 2001, the Elizabeth Fry Society of Manitoba initiated a community-based research process to gain a better understanding of this behaviour. Since then, two research projects have been undertaken as well as collaborative, community-based, knowledge translation activities.

This presentation will discuss the holistic definition of self-harm that evolved from the project; describe how the findings were disseminated in a collaborative community-based process; and highlight successful and challenging experiences with a collaborative research process when studying issues such as self-harm.
