

# Appraisal of Rural Women's Reproductive Health Management: Programs and Practices in India

Dr. Singal will present findings from a recent study which focuses on reproductive health care (RHC) practices of rural women in north India. The study examines awareness and use of various government programs, services and compliance with RCH recommendations. In spite of the educational component under RHC programs, women still indulged in indigenous beliefs and practices. These findings point towards important implications for policymakers, researchers and field practitioners.

**Dr. Savita Singal** is the current visiting scholar at the Pauline Jewitt Institute for Women Studies at Carleton University. She is a Professor in Family Resource Management at CCS Haryana Agricultural University located in Hisar, India. The focus of her work at Carleton is Globalization, poverty, and women's health.
